EVENT VENUE	THE TYNE YOUTH AND COMMUNITY CENTRE, MARINERS LANE, TYNEMOUTH, TYNE AND WEAR, NE30.....
REGISTRATION AND WEIGH IN	SUN 12 <sup>TH</sup> SEPT 2010 between 8-9 am at the Tyne Youth and Community Centre. Players licence must be produced during registration
QUALIFICATION AND CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES	The minimum grade to enter the competition will be green belt and must hold a valid BJA/BJC licence. All entries must be received before FRI 27 <sup>TH</sup> AUG. The organiser advises competitor's to apply in duplicate via e mail and on paper to avoid the possibility of any confusion with entries.
ENTRY FEE	The entry fee for the event will be £12.00 payable with the initial application or on the day of the event. Entry fees will only be refunded in exceptional circumstances. Registered Coaches and children under the age of 10 will be allowed free entry to the event. All others will be charged £3.00 as spectators.



COACHES	All mat side coaches must be in possession of their relevant and in date coach award. Only one coach will be allowed mat side for each fighter.
PAYMENT	Payment via paper entry applications can be by way of a cheque made payable to BJA NORTHERN AREA with the entry form by the 27 <sup>th</sup> August 2010.
METHOD	Compound knockout with repechage unless a pool has 4 players than a pool (S) system may be used. Four players = Gold, Silver and Bronze only Five players and above = four medals
